The Cornwall Curling Club is a modern, wheelchair-accessible, 4-sheet facility located in the Town of Cornwall's Civic Centre. The non-profit Club was founded in 1982, and rents its facilities from the Town. The clubhouse and ice plant with Jet Ice were replaced in 2011. Although located in Cornwall, we have members from all over Queens County.

Curling is great exercise, and a lot of fun! We have programs to suit your schedule, ability, and budget, including competitive, semi-competitive and commercial league team curling, single entry mixed draws, and stick curling. We have a very successful Junior program and fun weekend bonspiels. Prospective members are invited to drop by at any time and see why we should be your curling club!

Why Curling?

Looking for a fun way to exercise in a sociable atmosphere, or a fun activity for your next work get-together? We invite you to give curling a try!

Curling is a sport that anyone, at almost any age, can play, and includes options for those with varying degrees of mobility impairment. It's not expensive, in comparison with other sports that require much more equipment, officials, and high registration fees. The sport is great exercise, increasing flexibility, and providing cardio, with over 2 miles walked in a typical curling game, and lots of sweeping exercise, too!

Joining or renting ice at a curling club is also a great social activity – allowing you to get together regularly with your friends and coworkers, and make new friends and business contacts. After each game, the two teams involved sit down at the table together, and share a drink or two, with the first “sociable” round, by custom, purchased by the winning team.

Weekend bonspiels provide a fun atmosphere for the recreational curler, with great music, off-ice activities, and food thrown in. There are also cashspiels and provincial championships for those who want to take their game up a notch, and curlers can advance to Canadian and World championships, and the Olympics.

Cornwall is well-known for its welcoming atmosphere, and support for curlers at all ages and levels, as well as great facilities and ice. We invite you to take a look at what we have to offer.

Membership Rates

Adult

May be paid 50% on registration night, and 50% on Dec. 1. \$15 Curl PEI/CCA fee (except for Commercial League) and HST is added to these rates. Debit, Visa/MC, cheques accepted.

One Evening Draw or two daytime sessions per week – \$200

Unlimited Evening-only draws– \$305

Unlimited Daytime-only draws – \$275

Unlimited (Day and Evening) – \$330

Couple Unlimited - \$570

Full-time Student (19+) Unlimited – \$220

Youth

Payment in full is due on registration night. \$15 Curl PEI/CCA fee and HST is added to these rates.

Little Rockers (age 6-7) – \$45 for one session, \$80 for both sessions

Novice (8-12) and Juniors (13-20) – \$120

Junior plus one evening draw – \$220

Locker rentals (may be shared)

\$25+HST. Bring your own lock.

Rental Rates

Book our ice, Club house and/or upstairs hall for your next office party, family bonspiel, or fun time with friends!

Renting one sheet of ice for 8 curlers for two hours is a bargain at about \$9 a person taxes in. We provide renters with curling brushes, and sliders and can also provide basic curling instruction We can seat up to 100 in our clubhouse area. Facilities are also available for rental in the upstairs Civic Centre hall. We have a number of catering options available, or you can use our kitchen facilities at no additional cost.

One-sheet rental for two hours: \$63 +HST = \$71.82

Four sheets for two hours: \$153+HST = \$174.42

Four sheets for four hours: \$248 +HST = \$282.72

Four sheets for eight hours: \$437+HST = \$498.18

Drop-in Curling Rates

We welcome “drop-in” curlers when space is available, and particularly in our 10 am weekday draw, where teams are made up as players arrive. Rate is \$10 for adults, \$5 for juniors, HST included (pay at the bar). A pack of 10 passes for the 10 am weekday draw is available for \$80.
